

## Lab Safety Poster

Using a large sheet of paper, you and your partner should create a safety poster explaining one safety rule found on pages R10 and R11 in the back of your book. We will NOT be making posters from the Electrical Safety or Animal Safety sections.

Your poster should fill an entire side of paper and may use words, pictures or a combination of the two. The poster must be readable. You must also include the appropriate red icon for your rule.

Ex. Never reach over a flame or heat source.

You would need to use the fire safety symbol on your poster.



Write both your names and hour on the back of the poster. Self evaluate your poster using the rubric below. Then ask the group across from you to evaluate your poster as well. Attach this rubric to the back of your poster as well.
